When: *Tuesday, May 14, 2024.* Students should arrive at the JCA at 6:00 pm. Woodwinds will report to the dressing room and Brass/Percussion will report to the black box for attendance and warm-up. The concert will begin at 6:30 and will feature just the 6th Grade Band performance (*An 8pm concert of our 7th and 8th grade follows, but students do not stay for that*). I expect the concert to be about a half hour in length. Doors to the auditorium will open at 6:00 for families to select seats. We will be requesting ushers and parents to help with attendance backstage for this concert. You can look for a volunteer email soon!
